How are "Feature" roles awarded for Ice Show 2019?

Each Ice Show is different. Eligibility for a feature assignment is not determined by previous shows and will not affect future Ice Shows.

Who is eligible for a feature role for Ice Show 2019?

- All skaters registered to participate in the Ice Show who are also registered in the Advanced or Competitive level for the Fall 2018 season.
- Skaters will be notified by email/letter of their role assignment.

How are Ice Show groups determined?

Ice Show groups are formed following the Fall 2018 registration. Skaters are grouped first by program level. Within each program level, groups are configured so that skaters of similar age and skating level are grouped together as much as possible.

As we are renting costumes this year, the availability of sizes/styles will be a factor in deciding which skaters will be in each group.

Opening Number/Closing Number

Each Ice Show is different. Eligibility for the opening and/or closing number is not determined by previous shows and will not affect future Ice Shows.

Who is eligible for the opening and/or closing number for Ice Show 2019?

- Any skater who is registered for Ice Show 2019 who is also registered for the Advanced or Competitive session for Fall 2018.
- Skaters will be notified by email/letter of which number they will be assigned to.

<u>Gold Medal Number</u>

Who is eligible for the Gold Medal Number for Ice Show 2019?

- Any skater who is registered for Ice Show 2019 who has achieved a complete Gold test as of the December 2018 test day.
- Home-club members only.
- Skaters will be notified by email/letter if they are eligible for the Gold Number.
